Meet your Computer Instructor

Get your Stamp Card

The Job Seeker badge program is using a stamp card that will allow you to keep track of the badges that you've earned. Your computer instructor will assign you a card and get you started on your first badge. Don't worry if you lose your card, you'll also receive emails as you earn your digital badges.

SHARING YOUR DIGITAL BADGES





Digital Badges are designed to be shared. Each badge has its own link that you can add to your resume, LinkedIn or share via social media.

1. CHECK YOUR EMAIL

You will receive an email for each badge that you earn.

2. CREATE A BADGR ACCOUNT

- The Job Seeker badges are issued by the Badgr.com website.
- Follow the links in your emails to create an account on Badgr.com

3. SHARE YOUR BADGES

- Click the "Share" button on a badge that you have earned.
- Add your digital badges to LinkedIn
 - o Add to the Certifications or Awards section of your profile
 - Copy and paste the badge link when asked for the URL
- Share it directly with Facebook, or Twitter
- Add the badge link to your resume
 - Type out the name of the badge
 - o Select the text and right click on it.
 - Select "Hyperlink" and paste in the link to your badge
